## ***Harvest News You Can Use***

### **Child Health Plus/Children's Medicaid -1-800-698-4KIDS**

Child Health Plus and Children's Medicaid are New York State funded health insurance plans available to children under 19 who live in New York State. The benefits include but aren't limited to:

- Well-child care, immunizations, and physical exams
- Diagnosis and treatment of illness and injury
- X-ray and lab tests
- Outpatient surgery and emergency care
- Prescription and non-prescription drugs
- Inpatient hospital medical or surgical care
- Short-term therapeutic outpatient services (chemotherapy, hemodialysis)
- Limited inpatient and outpatient treatment for alcoholism, substance abuse, and mental health
- Dental and vision care
- Speech and hearing

**There are no copayments for any of the services provided by the plans.**

#### **Child Health Plus**

**The following premiums are for enrollments after 9/1/08**

- A family of three would pay no premium if their gross monthly income is at or below \$2,346 per month.
- A family of three with a gross monthly income of \$5,867 would pay \$40 per month per child.
- The premium is capped at three children so the most you will pay is \$120 per month no matter how many children you have.

#### **Children's Medicaid**

**The following eligibility levels are for enrollments after 1/1/08**

- A family of three with children between the ages of 1-5 would qualify if they have a gross monthly income of \$1,951.
- A family of three with children between the ages of 6-18 would qualify if they had a gross monthly income of \$1,467.
