

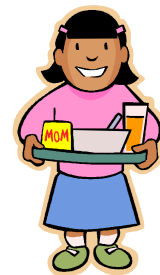


Harvest News You Can Use
2009-2010 Income Guidelines for
Free and Reduced-Price School Breakfasts and Lunches

The USDA has just come out with new income guidelines that are used to determine whether a family is eligible for free or reduced-price school meal programs or free milk programs. These guidelines are in effect from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

The guidelines are used by schools, institutions, and facilities participating in:

- The National School Lunch Program
- School Breakfast Program
- Special Milk Program for Children
- Child and Adult Care Food Program
- Summer Food Service Program



Reduced Price Lunch Income Guidelines

Household Size	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Income	\$26,955	\$33,874	\$40,793	\$47,712	\$54,631	\$61,550	\$68,469

Add \$6,919 for each additional family member beyond 8

Free Lunch Income Guidelines

Household Size	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Income	\$18,941	\$23,803	\$28,665	\$33,527	\$38,389	\$43,251	\$48,113

Add \$4,862 for each additional family member beyond 8.
